

Deeping & District Darts League
Minutes of General Meeting
13th April 2022 – The Bell

Teams Represented : Whistle Stop, Waggon & Horses, The Bell, The Bull, Deeping Sports & Social A, Rugby Club A & B, Walnut Tree A,B & C

The meeting commenced at 7:05pm

Apologies for Absence were received from the Lord Burghley (and it subsequently turned out that the DSS B team had not received the email about the 7pm start time and otherwise would have attended)

Chairman's Remarks

The Chairman welcomed the teams new to the league and thanked everyone in the league for playing during the season.

Minutes of Last Meeting

These were read and approved as being an accurate record.

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer reported current balances amounting to £1,054. Some league fees received for the 2020 season had been refunded. It was confirmed that League Fees would remain the same at £30 per team. Player Fees and Competition Fees would remain at £1.

End of season trophies had been purchased at a cost of £136.

Secretary's Report

The Secretary reported that there had been three Committee meetings and no items of correspondence. No proposals had been received.

Fixtures Secretary's Report

Teams were thanked for submitting Match Results promptly and particular mention was made of the assistance given by Martin Adams in keeping the website up to date. The standard of play during the season had been remarkably high considering the enforced Covid interlude.

The new season would commence with the Blind Doubles on 4th May, to be held at The Bell.

Team Registrations

11 teams have registered for the Summer Season. There will be 2 divisions, to be split based on the finishing positions from last season, and more competitions will be held.

Any Other Business

The running of 2 divisions for the Summer League was discussed and approved without dissent.

The provision of food on match nights will be left to each venue to decide upon (previously the Committee had recommended that food should not be offered to minimize contact between players).

It was suggested that a charity night be held in aid of the Ukrain appeal. All were in agreement and Mark Johnson was appointed Chairman of a sub-committee to organise this.

There being no other business the Chairman thanked The Bell for hosting and closed the meeting at 7:36pm.
